Principles for taking up complaints against Quackery.

- 1. Whenever a complaint (Oral/Written) received, President and Secretary of state branches shall discuss and take up the matter.
- 2. Documentary evidence of Quackery like Prescriptions, Letterheads, Brochures, Information leaflets, Electronic/Print media advertisements, is mandatory.
- 3. Complaints should not be based on professional rivalries or personal grudges
- 4. President and Secretary of state Branches shall ascertain the facts by crosschecking/ by verifying with other members who are in the same area/city/Metro.
- 5. Where ever there are some doubts, please use wisdom and discretion and if necessary contact ITAQ Chairmen on email for any clarifications and guidance.
- 6. Each state branch shall constitute an "ADHOC COMMITTEE" consisting of five members, the current year President and three past Presidents of State branch and State ITAQ representative, to decide about final decision of lodging a complaint against quackery
